



CHILDHOOD WHIMSY INSPIRED MY SCENIC DESIGN: A MIX OF REALISTIC DETAILS AND EXAGGERATED ARCHITECTURE GROUNDED THE SCENERY WHILE PROVIDING A FRAME FOR THE CABARET STYLE MUSICAL NUMBERS. FOUND ITEMS SUCH AS THE BASKETBALL HOOP, BLEACHERS, EXIT SIGN, DOUBLE DOORS AND PRACTICAL PAN LIGHTS PROVIDED TOUCHSTONES TO THE REALITY WHILE THE SKEWED UPPER EDGE ADDED TO THE CREATIVE ENERGY OF THE SCHOOL. TRANSLUCENT PORTIONS OF THE SET AND VARIED FLOOR PLANKS FURTHER ENHANCED THE PLAYING SPACE.





BANDSTAND

THE BANDSTAND PROVIDED AN OPPORTUNITY TO CREATE A FUNCTIONAL YET STRIKING PIECE. RESEARCH UNCOVERED CIRCULAR BANDSTANDS THAT I FELT WERE RECOGNIZABLY "PERIOD" AND SERVED AS A STRONG FOCAL POINT FOR A BUSY STAGE.

Wall units, judiciously positioned around the stage, suggested the larger architecture of the radio station. Each section clearly referenced the period and allowed the audience to complete the building in their minds. Contemporary photos provided a wealth of inspiration.

Numerous specialty props were created for this production and were workshopped prior to the first day of rehearsals. Creating the set dressings and props while keeping up with a changing concept was a challenge.




Work on this production also included scenic art for the floor as well as the distressing of the set, each prop, and all set dressings which totaled to over 300 individual items.






